Notification about Parent's Rights to request Title One Information

Under new regulations with the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), Irvine schools that receive Title I funding have applied and been School Board approved to operate a schoolwide Title 1 program in order to best meet the needs of all students in closing the achievement gap. Title I provides financial assistance to schools with high percentages of children from socio-economically disadvantaged families to help ensure that all students meet the challenging state standards. South Lake is one of the twelve schools in IUSD receiving Title I funds. As a result, we are designated as a schoolwide program to positively impact all students rather than a targeted specific group. Our Title I Program positively impacts students by providing lower class sizes, additional instructional support through Instructional Assistants, research-based interventions, increased access to technology and Counseling supports. We will evaluate the plan regularly to determine the effectiveness of our efforts to increase student achievement.
